

Uniform Policy

ALASHBAL International Kindergarten - Ainkhaled

Objective

Our school's uniform policy aims to:

- Foster a strong sense of identity and belonging among students.
- Enhance school safety.
- Encourage better student behavior.
- Reduce the cost of school clothing.
- Promote academic success.

Rationale

The purpose of encouraging students to wear school uniforms is to make them feel as though they belong at ALASHBAL International Kindergarten — Ainkhaled. Students are expected to maintain a high quality of personal appearance at all times, both on and off the school. All students are ambassadors of ALASHBAL International Kindergarten — Ainkhaled, and as such, we expect the cooperation of all parents, as their conduct reflects on us all. This involves their path of educational journey, and It promotes pride in the learning environment and community recognition of ALASHBAL International Kindergarten — Ainkhaled students.

Our classroom atmosphere and core values of compassion, excellence, integrity, respect, and accountability are supported by student uniforms. As a school located in Qatar, the uniform was chosen to show respect for the culture of the host country as well as to encourage self-respect and responsibility. Our dress code standards have been incorporated into the design of our uniform clothes.

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Uniform & Dress Code

- All uniforms must be of an appropriate size (not excessively large), and boys' shirts must always be tucked in at the midsection.
- The sleeves of shirts, skirts, and pants should never be rolled up and NO Belts
- Students should wear black shoes and white socks. Black shoes should be polished in a regular manner.
- No modifications, substitutions, or additional parts should be added to the uniforms.
- Wearing any form of outerwear, such as sunglasses or a cap, is strictly prohibited within the school premises and classrooms.
- Not permitted any kind of visible body modification, such as tattoos and piercings.
- The uniforms should be the same as in the list of uniforms provided and should be purchased from the school.
- To facilitate the return of lost and found items, parents should label all uniforms, including bags, lunchboxes, water bottles, and other personal belongings.

PE UNIFORMS

- Only when participating in PE classes should students wear their PE uniforms.
- Students should wear black shoes suitable for sports activities with white socks.
- Regarding Physical Education Classes Physical education is a required part of the curriculum, so students should wear PE uniforms even if they are ill or injured, as PE staff will assign appropriate activities based on their condition.
- Only upon obtaining a medical certificate or note from parent or guardian could a student be allowed to withdraw from any form of physical education.
- Students are not allowed to wear earrings to physical education classes due to safety concerns.

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Hair Styles for girls

Hair should be properly pulled back from the face. To keep hair neat and organized, it is permitted to use hair accessories in a responsible manner, such as an Alice band or hair clips. Slide elastic bands, etc., should be made of plastic in either white or black.

Hair Styles for Boys

It is imperative that male students maintain a well-groomed hairstyle consistently. The hair should be sufficiently far from the natural color and should not extend beyond the ears and face. Additionally, it should not be trimmed lower than a length equivalent to a number 2 guard on a hair clipper, and complete shaving of the hair is to be avoided. The display of lengthy hair, dyed hair, and extended nails is strictly prohibited.

Jewelry

Students may wear watches except smart watches, and allow female pupils to wear small ear studs in their earlobes, which must be removed for physical education.

Makeup and Nail polish

There is a strict no-makeup policy, including no nail paint.

NON-Uniform days

In the case of Special events, certain days may be declared non-uniform days. In a multicultural school environment, students should have the awareness to remain sensitive to the local Qatari culture and expectations on non-uniform days, where clothing should not be revealing and clothing should be neat and tidy.

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The Role of parents

All parents are responsible for ensuring that their child has the appropriate uniform, PE equipment, and shoes. If the child is not donning the correct uniform, a reminder slip will be sent home, and if the issue persists, the parents may be called to the school.

Compliance Measures

All students are required to adhere to the School uniform policy by donning the correct uniform daily, both during physical education and, at the school adhering to total compliance. Extra-large or tight uniforms, discolored uniforms or uniforms with stains or damages are not permitted to wear. The school should only resort to disciplinary action if rewards and positive reinforcement are ineffective in ensuring compliance. In addition, the school's rationale and the benefits of wearing a uniform should be explained to the student and his or her family so that they are thoroughly comprehended.

Procedure of purchasing the uniform

As per school policy all uniforms should ONLY be purchased through school.

Monitoring and reviving

The school management is responsible for monitoring and revising the school uniform policy by adhering MOE requirements.
